

TISSUE REQUIREMENTS FOR SOLID TUMOR NEXT-GENERATION SEQUENCING

The following specimen requirements ensure testing can proceed without delay and increases the likelihood of successfully generating sequencing results.

ACCEPTABLE SAMPLES


Preliminary or final pathology reports should accompany all specimens.

1. Formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded (FFPE) tissue

- Tissue should be fixed in 10% neutral-buffered formalin. Other fixatives not acceptable unless otherwise noted.
- Decalcified specimens are not acceptable.

2. Cytology smears*

- Slides prepared from fine needle aspirations or touch preps.
- Slides prepared from Thin Prep.
- Plastic coverslips not preferred and require extra processing time.



*Cytology smears not accepted for test codes NONCP or NTRK
